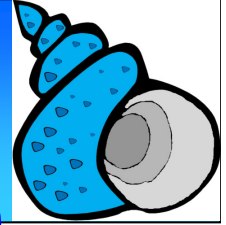

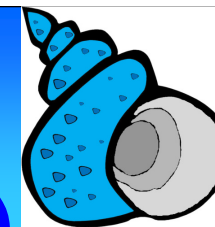

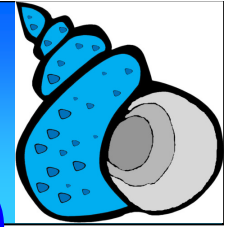

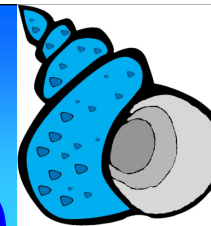

Feeling the difficulty of moving when trapped into a plastic bag



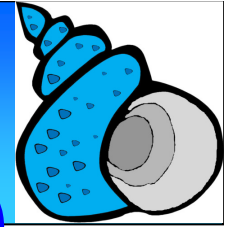


The suffocation game

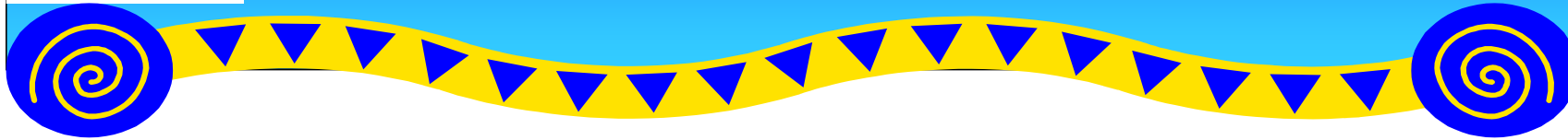
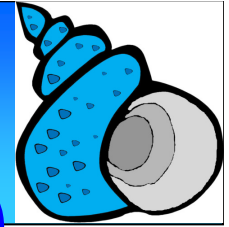
